It covers an area of around 230 square miles (almost 600 square kilometers) and conceals the Katla volcano. Myrdalsjokull has numerous glacier outlets known as glacial tongues. These create magnificent ice formations, including ice caves and crevasses. The Kotlujokull glacier is one of Myrdalsjokull's glacier tongues on the eastern side of the Katla volcano. It's known for its dramatic and rugged terrain, deep crevasses, ice formations, and stunning ice caves. It's one of these ice caves that you'll
